I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold and
delivered by these presents do grant bargain sell & deliver unto the
said Doctor Robert Hood a negro girl a slave for life named Matilda
Lee about twenty nine years of age, white hair & girl I will warrant
and defend to the said Doctor Robert Hood his executors administrators
& assigns against me my executors administrators & against every
other person or persons whomsoever, In witness whereof I have hereunto
