In the name of God, Amen,
I, Joseph Behr, of the Borough
of Carrolltown, in the County of Cam-
bria and State of Pennsylvania,
being of sound mind, memory and
understanding, but feeble in health,
and knowing the uncertainty of hu-
man life do, make and publish this
following as and for my last will
and testament. Revocably making and
making void any will by me for-
merly or heretofore made.

First, I bequeath my soul to Al-
mighty God, its Giver, and my body
at my decease I direct to be de-
cently interred in St. Benedict's Cem-
etery in Carrolltown, Penna, according
to the ~~rites~~ and ceremonies of the
Catholic Church.

Secondly; As to such worldly goods
as it has pleased Almighty God to en-
trust me with I direct ~~as follows~~
follows. I will and direct that
my funeral and burial expenses be
first paid out of my estate and
all my just debts, likewise, to be
so paid. To this end and purpose
I have deeded to my beloved wife, Jane
Behr, my real estate consisting of my

consent in which I have been with
my family and which is fully de-
scribed in said deed, dated May 13th
1836, and I hereby ratify said deed by
bequeathing and giving said real estate
to my said wife, Jane Bebe.

As to the residue of my real estate
sold by articles of agreement to my
son Henry Bebe, I direct and here-
by empower and authorize my ex-
ecutors, hereinafter named, on the
full compliance with the terms of the
said agreement on the part of the said
Henry Bebe, to make, execute and
deliver to him a good and sufficient
deed for the same according to the pro-
visions of said agreement, which has
been duly recorded. But in case of the
failure of the said Henry Bebe to com-
ply with the said agreement, then
I hereby authorize empower and direct
my executors to sell and deed the
said premises to the best advantage,
with a power to them to apply the
the payment of the debts against said
property, and to re-imburse and re-
fund to Henry Bebe the money and
value of the improvements paid by and
put in said property, by him.
As to my personalty, I will and

Bequeath to my daughter Catherine the
music organ now in my possession
to be hers absolutely and unconditio-
nally. As to my sons Henry Bebe
and Matthew Bebe I hereby bequeath,
ratify and confirm to them the per-
sonal property given to them by wri-
tings and possession during my life-
time and prior to the making of this
my last will and testament and
desire them to have and enjoy the
same.

As to all the residue of my person-
al property, book accounts, bills re-
ceivable &c. I direct that my ex-
ecutors shall collect the same as soon
as they reasonably can after my decease
and appropriate the proceeds thereof to
the payment of all my just debts,
and should any surplus or overplus
remain it is to be divided, share and
share alike between my beloved wife
Jane Bebe and my loving daughters
Rose Bebe (Sister M. Agnes) and Cath-
erine Bebe.

I hereby nominate and appoint
my beloved wife Jane Bebe and
Benjamin Winter to be the execu-
tors of this my last will and

testament whereby giving them full
power to make such or deeds should
the same be necessary,

In witness whereof I, Joseph Beke, the
testator here to this my will, (written
on two sheets), set my hand and seal
this thirteenth day of May A. D. one
thousand eight hundred and eighty six,
Signed, sealed, published and
declared by the aforesaid
Joseph Beke, as and for his
last will and testament, in
the presence of us who have
hereto subscribed our names
at his request as witnesses thereto
